Mark Dennison, Golf Course Superintendent

We have a long way to go before spring arrives, but after the last snow melt off, the course looked good. I walked around most of the course and we had no snow mold that I could see, and the turf looked healthy.

Last year, for the first time in 8 years, we aerified the greens twice. In February, when we had the warm-up, we core aerified in-house. We borrowed Morris Park's core harvester, a device that picks up the plugs, and had the greens done in a couple of days. Then, come the latter part of September, we deep tined the greens going down approximately 8" to break up the hard pan and compaction. I'm in hopes we can do the same thing this season. I heard many comments from members and non-members alike that they thought our greens were as good as or better than any around. Let's hope we can duplicate this achievement this upcoming season.

While we are on the topic of greens, we still have way too many ball marks. I realize our play has increased, but I watched numerous old-time members more than once not fix ball marks last year. I know as we age it's not as easy to bend down to fix your ball mark, but this can't be an excuse. Christiana Creek's greens are very small compared to newer courses. Every time a ball mark isn't repaired, it can take up to 10 days for the ball mark to heal. If that mark hasn't been repaired properly, it may just be in your putting line next time out. Some courses have paid personnel that do nothing but go out for hours a day to repair ball marks. This isn't in the cards for us, so please remember to repair your ball mark plus one more. Thank you.

We are in the process of putting together member tournaments for the year. The first and last events will be the Par 3 Shootout. This has always been well attended and seems to be enjoyed by all participants. The participation level for our other member tournaments is lacking. The Day/Night golf outing has a decent turnout, but that's about it. Why? For as long as I've been at CCCC, it has been very difficult to get members to play in events. I don't know if it's our handicapping or what, but we really need to get this rectified. If you have any suggestions, please email me at elkssup@yahoo.com.
